Client & home information

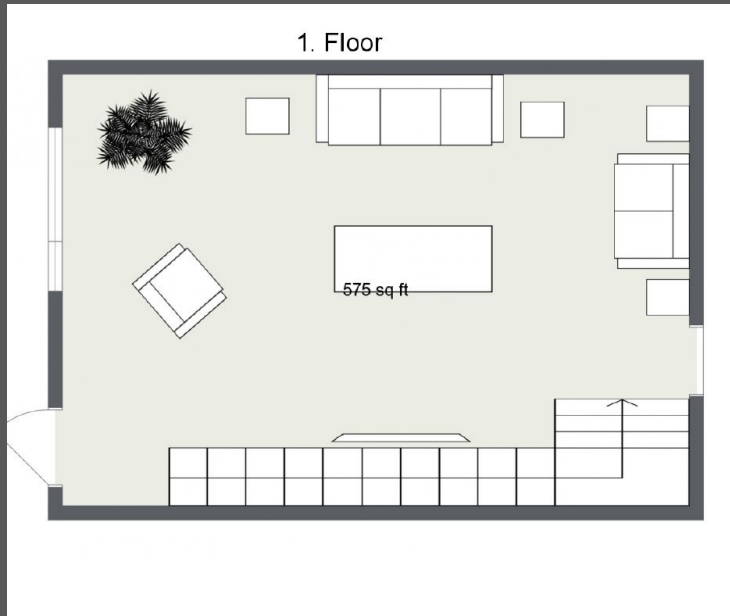
- Client is in her late 50s, has lived by herself in a townhouse duplex for about 20 years

- Her house is very dark, not a lot of natural light, there is a lot of dark tile and carpet throughout her house, and the walls are also all painted dark colors
- Looking to add more natural light, paint walls bright and neutral colors, and add pops of color and make home more inviting and have a more “homier” feel

Living room- client requests

- Client wants a beige and neutral color palette for the living room
- Wants to add more sunlight into the room and remove old window
- Wants to replace old, dark furniture with cream color furniture that matches walls

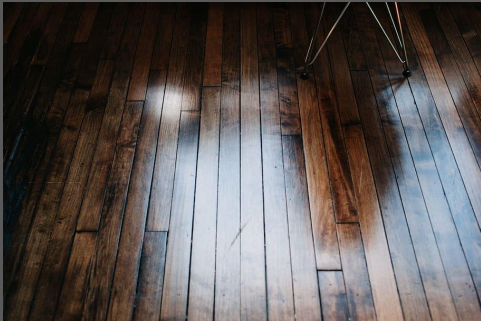
- Client wants to add a bay window for more use of natural light
